**Subject: *Humble Request to Allow 16+ Students to Commute by Scooty During Extreme Summer Conditions***

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, on behalf of the students of GMSSSS D/C Jind, most respectfully submit this application to draw your kind attention towards a pressing concern affecting many of us in this scorching summer season.

As per a recent directive issued by the District Commissioner, students from certain villages have been restricted from commuting via two-wheelers. While we understand and appreciate the intent behind this order, we humbly request your kind consideration of the challenges we are facing due to this in the current circumstances.

Many students travel from villages located more than 7 kilometers away from the school. With daytime temperatures soaring above 45°C after 11 AM, walking or cycling such long distances daily under direct sunlight poses serious health risks such as heat strokes, dehydration, and sunburns. The harsh afternoon heat is not only exhausting but also dangerous, especially when students are already burdened with academic responsibilities and summer exams.

Therefore, we kindly request you to allow students who are 16 years and above, and to commute responsibly on their scooties at speeds not exceeding 30–35 km/h, while wearing helmets. We assure you that we will follow all safety protocols strictly and responsibly.

This small consideration will greatly ease our daily struggle, ensure our timely and safe attendance, and most importantly, protect our health during this extreme season.

We sincerely hope that you will empathize with our situation and forward our request to the concerned authorities for necessary permission.
